## Sentence Structure Review

You have learned about three sentence structures. **Simple sentences** are one independent clause—expresses a complete thought and has a subject and a verb. **Compound sentences** are two independent clauses joined together with a conjunction or a semicolon. **Complex sentences** contain one independent clause and a dependent clause (has a subject and a verb, but does not express a complete thought).

Here are some examples of each type:

- **Simple:** Cara and Joe are cousins. Mary will wake up early and go fishing tomorrow.
- **Compound:** Cara and Joe are cousins, but they live in different states.  
Marvin was late to practice, so Coach Lance made him run.
- **Complex:** Before we can go outside, everyone has to finish the quiz.  
Can I have your dessert since you are not going to eat it?
